


Artistic rendering of the Phoenician harbor at Atlit; looking E



- **1219/1220: Siège par Malik al-Muazzam**
- **1265: Sac de la ville par le Sultan Baybars**
- **Le 14 août 1291, les Templiers évacuent Chastel-Pèlerin suite à la prise d'Acre**
- **Démantèlement partiel du château**
- **Destructions plus récentes:**
  - **1772: Cheik Daher el-Omar (gouverneur d'Acre) « fait démolir le Château Pèlerin »**
  - **Soliman Pacha (1811 et 1816) et Ibrahim Pacha (1838) font extraire des pierres pour rénover les défenses d'Acre.**
  - **1837 un tremblement de terre détruisit une partie des vestiges.**

  - 2006 : PhD thesis (J. Thompson)
  - 2014 : Survey and expertise
  - 2015 – 2017... : 15 days (Y. Gleize dir.)
  - 2018 – 2021: mission MEAE (Y. Gleize dir.)



## **Goals of research on ‘Atlit cemetery since 2014**

- Analysis of the 1934 excavation data
- Impact of restoration of the cemetery
- Possibility to realize small-scale excavations
- Identification of different funerary practices
- Analysis of the internal architecture of graves
- First biological analysis
- Sampling for dating
- Sampling for ancient DNA analysis









# Spatial distribution of gravestones



**Schematic sectional view**











### Examples of episodes of violence around Château Pèlerin

- 1265 : plunder of the town by Al-Malik Baybars




Plan général du site - Mai 2014
